- **Elementary Education for Grades 4-6 is an approved content area at the MAT 4-6 Elementary Education Licensure level for grades 4-6. Prior to admission to the MAT Alt/Cert program applicants are required to have taken and have a passing score on the Praxis II 5018 Elementary Education Content Knowledge Test. Elementary Education content area can only be recommended for the First/Initial Licensure Recommendation and never as an add-on supplemental endorsement.
- **Alternate Route Elementary Teacher Education for Licensure Grades K-6 is dependent on candidates successfully finishing the complete 33 credit hour MAT K-6 master's degree program.
- All Mississippi Elementary Licenses require candidates to take and pass the Foundations of Reading Test (FOR) after successfully completing EDU 506, EDU 501, & EDU 602 and prior to recommendation for the Three-Year Alternate Route License.
