**Daniel Koehn Brings Dramatic Storytelling of "The Public Ministry of Jesus" to  
Belhaven College Center for the Arts**

**JACKSON, Miss. (Oct. 30, 2003)** - Daniel Koehn will bring the Scriptures to life at 7:30 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 12, in a one-man show from the first 12 chapters of the Gospel of John. "The Public Ministry of Jesus," a dramatic storytelling, will be presented in the Belhaven College Flex Theatre in the Center for the Arts, located at 835 Riverside Drive.

See Jesus as He turns the water into wine, feeds the 5,000, heals the man born blind and teaches in the synagogue. The script is taken exclusively from the New International Version of the Bible.

Koehn is currently in the final year of a master's degree program in biblical studies at Wesley Biblical Seminary. He holds a bachelor's degree in vocal performance from Asbury College and an master's degree in vocal performance from the University of Kentucky.

Before coming to seminary, Koehn worked as a professional singer with such companies as Central City Opera, Opera Omaha, Lyric Opera of Chicago, San Diego Opera, and Long Beach Opera, among others.

The son of a minister, Koehn lived in several northern midwestern states during his early years. He and his wife, Renita, moved to the Jackson area from San Diego three years ago. Renita, who is the primary director of this dramatic presentation from the gospel of John, is on the music faculty of Belhaven College. Daniel and Renita enjoy presenting concerts of music and drama in local churches.
