Kimmel holds a doctorate in international development from the University of Southern Mississippi, a Master of Business Administration from Millsaps and a Bachelor of Science degree in business from Belhaven College. Kimmel is very involved in the local community, where she has worked with Girl Scouts, United Way, Steel Magnolias Chapter and Red Cross. She served Belhaven as an adjunct professor last year.
