## **Belhaven College Named One of Top Christian Business College**

**Jackson, Miss. (September 9, 2004)** – Belhaven College was recently selected as one of the top Christian business colleges in the country by Business Reform Magazine in their September/October issue. Belhaven College also received special recognition as an editor’s pick for most biblical curriculum and focus.

“It is gratifying to get this kind of recognition,” said Chip Mason, dean of the school of business. “Such recognition is only possible if your faculty is committed to teaching from a biblical worldview, and with this recognition we should be able to build on an already strong faculty.”

The editors of Business Reform magazine researched and surveyed over 100 schools nationwide that met the qualifications in four main components. They examined the foundation of the program, the emphasis placed on running a business vs. teaching students to get a job, how the school's business department heads rank other programs in overall quality and what colleges offered the most business degrees and courses
