William Dembski Speaks on Intelligent Design and Darwin at Belhaven College

JACKSON, Miss. (August 30, 2004) – Dr. William Dembski, a mathematician and philosopher, will examine and analyze the connections linking chance, probability and intelligent causation at Belhaven College's Center of the Arts on Thursday, September 30 and Friday, October 1 at 6:30 p.m.

Dembski's seminar's, "Intelligent Design: Yesterday's Orthodoxy, Today's Heresy," and "Darwin's Unpaid Debt," are free and open to the public.

Dembski is associate research professor in the conceptual foundations of science at Baylor University and a senior fellow with Discovery Institute's Center for Science and Culture in Seattle. He is also the executive director of the International Society for Complexity, Information and Design.

Dembski has published articles in mathematics, philosophy and theology journals and is the author and editor of ten books including; "The Design Inference: Eliminating Chance Through Small Probabilities," "Uncommon Dissent: Intellectuals Who Find Darwinism Unconvincing," and "Debating Design: From Darwin to DNA."
