Samuel Hensley Speaks on Stem Cell Research at Belhaven College

JACKSON, Miss. (August 20, 2004) – Dr. Samuel Hensley, surgical pathologist at Mississippi Baptist Medical Center and assistant clinical professor at the University of Mississippi School of Medicine, will speak on stem cell research on September 10 at 6:30 p.m. in the Barber Auditorium located at Belhaven College.

Hensley's seminar is part of the department of biology's Fall Seminar Series and is titled; "Bioethics: Stem Cell Research." The seminars are free and open to the public.

Hensley serves as course director for a fourth year medical student elective in contemporary Christian bioethics and participates on the ethics committee for the Mississippi Baptist Medical Center. He is also a Fellow of the Center for Bioethics and Human Dignity. Hensley lectures in courses at Reformed Theological Seminary in Jackson, particularly in the areas of pastoral care and its interface with bioethics.
