Belhaven College to Begin Honors College This Fall

JACKSON, Miss. (April 12, 2004) — In fall 2004, Belhaven College will begin an Honors College for select students, with the goal to deepen and expand their college education, both intellectually and spiritually.

The Honors College will provide focused discussion of books and issues as well as interaction with guest speakers. It will also provide students opportunities for field trips, cultural events, participation in conferences and mentoring relationships with faculty.

“Our desire is to foster a cohesive scholarly community among our top students, instilling in them a passion for learning and a sense of the interrelatedness of all knowledge within a Christian worldview,” said Dr. Melissa Hause, dean of the Honors College.

Admission to the program is based on grade point average and ACT/SAT scores, as well as a written essay and a personal interview. To be selected, students must demonstrate academic achievement, seriousness about their calling, and enthusiasm for working with people from a variety of fields. Those who successfully complete the Honors College will receive special honors at graduation.
