REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO THE TEPP TEACHER EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROGRAM

TESTING REQUIREMENTS & DEADLINE DATES FOR ADMISSION TO THE TEPP

- PRAXIS- PLT- Principles of Learning and Teaching (#5622) Achieve a qualified passing score by the completion of the first semester of your Junior year within the TEPP. Qualifying Score – 160+
- PRAXIS-CIA-Curriculum Instruction and Assessment (#5017) Achieve a qualified passing score by the <u>completion</u> of the second semester of your Junior year within the TEPP. Qualifying Score – 153+
- Foundations of Reading Assessment FOR Achieve a qualified passing score by the <u>completion of the first</u> semester of your Senior year. Foundations of Reading Assessment (Test Code #1980) – Qualifying Score – 233 Testing Information as of July 1, 2021

ADMITTANCE TO TEACHER EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS & INTERVIEW DOCUMENTATION

Candidates must have successfully completed at least 60 TEPP approved hours of course work prior to Application.

Candidates are to prepare the following information for the interview in a professional organized folder, which will be added to his/her teacher candidate records in the School of Education Office:

- **Cover Page** professionally organized and prepared.
 - Include the following information:
 <u>Candidate's Full Name</u> <u>Candidate's ID Number</u> <u>Date of Interview</u>

Organize the Interview Folder in the Following Order:

- Application
- Introduction Letter
- <u>Candidate's Philosophy of Education</u>
 - GPA 3.0 or Higher without the required qualifying assessment scores (CORE, ACT, or SAT) OR
 - Have a 2.75 with the required qualifying assessment scores (CORE, ACT, or SAT)
 - <u>Test Documents</u>- Initial and the PLT- REQU
 - Must successfully pass ONE of the following three tests-
 - ACT showing a 21 or higher composite with no sub-score lower than 18.
 - You will need to contact ACT if you do not have an official unopened copy to submit. MDE will also need an official copy prior to your senior year.
 - OR CORE Academic Skills for Educators
 - Composite test of all three Test # 5751
 - **OR** Individual portions of the tests as below
 - See minimum scores below.
 - Reading minimum score- 156 Test # 5712
 - o Writing minimum score- 162 Test # 5722
 - o Mathematics minimum score- 150 Test # 5732
 - OR SAT with score of at least 990 without writing
 - PLT Must also pass the *Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT)* for your area-160
- Professional Dispositions Evaluation Forms: Must be completed by education faculty members and/or Clinical Educator (2 completed).
- □ Acknowledgement of Understanding of the Mississippi Code of Ethics for Educators
- **DRESS PROFESSIONALLY** and be prepared to discuss your thoughts about education.
