

## Adjunct Instructors

Undergraduate adjunct instructors are required to hold at least a Master's Degree from a regionally accredited institution with a minimum of 18 graduate hours in their teaching discipline. Graduate adjunct instructors are required to hold the terminal degree in their field from a regionally accredited institution with a minimum of 18 graduate hours in their teaching discipline. All adjunct instructors must possess an understanding of, and a commitment to, the integration of evangelical Christian faith within their academic discipline.

7. Your philosophy of teaching adult learners, and the role student participation plays in your classroom
