Faculty Position – Department of Chemistry and Physics

Belhaven University, a Christian university committed to the ministry of integrating biblical truth and learning, is searching for a candidate for a professor in the Department of Chemistry & Physics at the traditional undergraduate campus in Jackson, Mississippi. This is an open-rank, tenure-track position.

The Chemistry & Physics Department values strong partnerships within the community and within the university. Current faculty are collaborative and collegial with other departments working together on research, recruitment, and other projects. We have an active American Chemical Society (ACS) Student Chapter and encourage students to engage in professional development, such as applying for internships and attending conferences.

Responsibilities

Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate students, mentoring students in career development, and participating in departmental activities that foster community. Demonstrated ability to conduct and supervise undergraduate student research projects is also required. Collectively, the new faculty and the other members of the department will help maintain the facilities and instrumentation in a well-equipped program.

Qualifications

An appropriate Ph.D. is required. The background of the applicant is flexible. Though candidates with a background related to analytical chemistry or those with expertise in maintaining instrumentation are highly preferred.
