Responsibilities

Clinical Instructors are registered nurses who serve as members of an instructional team under the leadership of a senior course faculty or course coordinator to ensure that the standards and quality of the nursing curricula are met and maintained. The clinical instructor plans and supervises the clinical laboratory practice for an assigned group of nursing students assuring that each student is exposed to a prescribed number and variety of learning situations that meet specific course objectives and are appropriate for their level of achievement. The typical work schedule is a maximum of 29 hours per week.

Qualifications

- Master's or higher degree with a major in nursing and a clinical focus, specialty certification or practice experience in adult health, maternal-child, psychiatric/mental health, or community/public health nursing.
- Possess and maintain a current, unencumbered RN license to practice in Mississippi with no pending legal or State Board of Nursing actions.
- Clinical experience - at least one year of clinical experience providing direct patient care in adult health, maternal-child, psychiatric/mental health and/or community/public health nursing.
- Must satisfy a criminal history background check and pass a drug screening test.
- Evidence of current American Heart Association BLS training.
- Evidence of yearly tuberculin skin tests and other required immunizations and laboratory results as per nursing program policy and/or agency requirements.
- Complete all required clinical agency and nursing program training including; but, not limited to electronic health records, HIPAA, blood-borne pathogens, tuberculosis precautions, and infection control.
- Be familiar and comply with clinical agency policies and procedures.

Applicants must be able to fully support the [University vision, mission and statement of faith](#), and contribute to the spiritual and academic fellowship of the university.
