Responsibilities:

This position, available immediately, is responsible for programing for multiple assigned sports as well as assistance with football. Qualifications:

A Bachelor's degree, previous strength and conditioning experience or experience as a collegiate athlete, strong work ethic and a current CPR/AED certification. Applicants must possess or be working towards certification through NSCA or CSCCa. Bachelor's degree and 2.5 GPA required to be admissible to desired graduate program if offered position.

Compensation includes a \$600 monthly stipend as well as full tuition waiver.
