Adjunct Faculty

Overview

Belhaven University is seeking adjunct faculty in the Department of Chemistry for the 2022-2023 academic year. Specific courses include General Chemistry I & II Lab courses.

Responsibilities

- Teach undergraduate General Chemistry Lab(s) in person at the Jackson, MS campus.
 - There are two sections that need an instructor for the Fall 2022 semester - one Wednesday from 1:15-4:15 and Thursday 5:30-8:30. These can be taught by the same adjunct instructor or different instructors.
- The hired adjunct instructor will NOT need to develop the individual lab experiments.
- Communicate with the department chair and/or other administration.
- Meet faculty guidelines regarding student engagement and deadlines.
- Manage course Canvas LMS pages for grading assignments, posting announcements, etc.

Qualifications

- Master's or doctorate degree in the physical or life sciences (chemistry, biology, physics, medicine, etc.). Current Ph.D. seeking graduate students will also be considered.
- Applicants must be able to fully support the University vision, mission and statement of faith and contribute to the spiritual and academic fellowship of the University.
