Adjunct Faculty: Creative Arts Therapy

Overview

Belhaven University is seeking adjunct faculty in the Department of Psychology for the 2023-2024 academic year. Specific courses taught include Creative Arts Therapy 1 and Creative Arts Therapy 2.

Responsibilities

- Teach undergraduate Creative Arts Therapy courses in person at the Jackson, MS campus.
- Creative Arts Therapy 1 is taught in the Fall semester. Creative Arts Therapy 2 is taught in the Spring semester. Courses can either be a Monday-Wednesday-Friday format or a Tuesday-Thursday format.
- The hired adjunct instructor will not need to develop the entire course, although the adjunct instructor may provide suggestions for the course in conjunction with department chair approval.
- Communicate with the department chair and/or other administration as needed.
- Meet faculty guidelines regarding student engagement and deadlines.
- Manage course Canvas pages for grading assignments, posting announcements, etc.

Qualifications

- Master's degree in counseling or creative arts therapy.
- Experience with creative arts therapy preferred.
- Applicants must be able to fully support the University vision, mission and statement of faith and contribute to the spiritual and academic fellowship of the University.
