BLAZENET ACCEPTABLE USAGE POLICY

The BlazeNet Acceptable Usage Policy is designed to help you understand Belhaven University's expectations for the safe and proper use of BlazeNet and to help you use the University's resources wisely.

1. Persons using BlazeNet shall identify themselves honestly, accurately, and completely (including one's affiliation and function where requested). Any information shared or posted on BlazeNet shall be respectful and free of profanity or inappropriate language.
2. User IDs and passwords help maintain individual accountability for BlazeNet use. Any person who obtains a password or ID from the University must keep that password confidential. University policy prohibits the sharing of user IDs or passwords.
3. The University has installed hardware and software to ensure the safety and security of the University's networks. Any person who attempts to disable, defeat, or circumvent any University security facility will be subject to disciplinary action.
4. Users may gain access to certain confidential information regarding the University, whether it be in written, spoken, or any other recorded format. This information should not be transferred in any way to any other person or device.
5. Use of any University resources for illegal activity is grounds for immediate suspension (students) or termination (employees), and the University will cooperate with any legitimate law enforcement investigation.
