To be considered for this position, a complete application packet must be received. A complete application packet will include the following:

- Letter of intent detailing interest in Christian higher education and how experience aligns with the position's qualifications and responsibilities.
- A statement (3–4 paragraphs) describing how a biblical worldview informs film production education and leadership.
- Current resume or curriculum vitae.
- Contact information for four professional references (including one from a local pastor).
- Please prepare a brief account (no more than 750 words) of your spiritual pilgrimage including the time and circumstances surrounding your becoming a believer in Christ and your current relationship with Christ. Please click on this link:
