



Full-Time Faculty Position – School of Business (Jackson, Mississippi)

Belhaven University, a Christian university committed to the ministry of integrating faith and learning, invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track faculty position in the School of Business. This is an on-campus position based at Belhaven University's main campus in Jackson, Mississippi. The successful candidate will teach in both our traditional undergraduate program and our online campus. The anticipated start date is negotiable.

Belhaven is located in the historic Belhaven residential neighborhood just north of downtown Jackson. Jackson is a pleasant city with parks, bike trails, and a thriving arts and cultural community. The School of Business values strong partnerships within the community and within the university. Current faculty are collaborative and collegial with other departments working together on research, recruitment, and other projects.

Responsibilities

- Teach business courses in Belhaven's traditional, on-campus undergraduate program in Jackson, Mississippi.
- Teach business courses in Belhaven's online programs, which may include undergraduate and graduate courses depending on qualifications and departmental needs.
- Write and/or revise curricula in the candidate's subject area and contribute to ongoing program development and assessment.
- Participate in scholarly activity, advising, service, recruitment, and other departmental activities that foster a collaborative academic community.

Required Qualifications

- The successful candidate must articulate a Christian worldview in one's area of service and must fully support the University Vision, Mission and Statement of Faith.

- A master's degree in a business-related or closely related discipline is required. A doctorate in Marketing or Management is preferred; however, candidates with doctoral degrees or significant academic preparation in other business-related disciplines will also be considered.
- Teaching experience at the college or university level is preferred. Experience teaching online is also preferred.
- The ability and willingness to teach effectively in both face-to-face and online formats is required.
- Professional or industry experience relevant to the candidate's teaching field is preferred, but not required.
- A record of, or demonstrated potential for, scholarly activity and service is preferred.

Application Process

To be considered for this position, a complete application packet must be received. The complete application packet will include the following:

- A cover letter outlining your suitability for this position, including an explanation of your interest in Christian higher education.
- A CV or Resume documenting both work history and academic background

- A 3 to 4 paragraph statement of how you would integrate the Biblical worldview into all instructional content.
- Please prepare a brief account (no more than 750 words) of your spiritual pilgrimage including the time and circumstances surrounding your becoming a believer in Christ and your current relationship with Christ. Please click on this link
