Responsibilities

Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate and graduate Business and Public Administration students in both classroom and online environments. In addition to Public Administration, the ability to teach Finance, Accounting, Business Law, and other business/management graduate courses would be a plus. Additional responsibilities include coordinating outcomes assessment and providing program management oversight for all public administration programs within the School of Business.

Qualifications

A Ph.D. or DBA with at least 18 graduate hours in Public Administration required. Candidates who possess a JD or a doctorate in a field closely-related to Public Administration will also be considered. Executive experience in a public setting is also required.

Persons possibly interested in applying may begin with a confidential phone conversation with the Dean for the School of Business. A confidential review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. Please submit the following: a CV, a cover letter outlining your suitability for this position including an explanation of your interest in Christian higher education, and a 3 to 4 paragraph statement of how you would integrate the Biblical worldview into all instructional content, and a brief account (750 words or less) of your spiritual pilgrimage including the time and circumstances surrounding your becoming a believer in Christ and your current relationship with Christ.
