Our programs include a traditional on-campus BSN program and an online RN-BSN program. Adjuncts may be needed for either of these programs, and some assignments may include clinical.

Responsibilities

- Teach courses as assigned, based on the needs of the programs. For the traditional on-campus program, assignments may be either in person at the Jackson, MS campus or at an assigned clinical site. For the online program, assignments will be to teach online courses with mandatory weekly engagement as designated by the course requirements.
- Communicate with the Dean, the assigned Program Director, and/or other administration.
- Work closely with the faculty to coordinate content with other courses in the program assigned.
- Meet faculty guidelines regarding student engagement and deadlines.
- Manage course Canvas LMS pages for grading assignments, posting announcements, etc.
- Implement an annual professional development plan, which meets the state-specific accreditation requirements.

Qualifications

- Must have a minimum of a graduate degree in nursing from a regionally accredited institution.
- Must have a minimum of one year of clinical experience as a registered nurse.
- Must hold an unencumbered license to practice in Mississippi or hold a multistate license from another NLC state with no pending legal or State Board of Nursing actions. Continued verification of this requirement will be necessary during employment.
- Must satisfy a criminal history background check and pass a drug screening test.
- Applicants must be able to fully support the University vision, mission and statement of faith and contribute to the spiritual and academic fellowship of the University.
- Prefer seasoned nursing educators with experience in teaching at either the baccalaureate or the advanced practice level and who have experience with teaching in the hybrid or online format.
