## Theatre Technical Director

Belhaven University, a Christian university committed to the ministry of integrating biblical truth and learning, is searching for the ideal candidate for a **Technical Director** in the Department of Theatre at the traditional undergraduate campus in Jackson, Mississippi. The full-time position is for 10 months of work covering August 1 to May 31 paid on an annual basis.

The Department of Theatre at Belhaven University is committed to preparing students academically, technically, artistically, and spiritually to serve their Community, their Collaborators, and their Creator in the world of theatre and related vocations. The department offers a BA in Theatre, with emphases in performance and production. The department produces a season of 4 mainstage productions. Belhaven University is accredited by the National Association of Schools of Theatre (NAST).

### Responsibilities

- The Theatre Technical Director will assist faculty and guest, and student designers in the implementation of scenic, lighting, sound, and prop designs for the department's production season.
- Teach students in the department's Scene Shop Lab and Lighting/Sound Lab courses.
- Opportunities for additional teaching assignments are available depending on the candidate's qualifications and interests.
- Generating technical drawings and build schedules;
- Supervise student workers and practicum students in production shops;
- Maintain an inventory and maintenance schedule for the department's equipment; contributing to and facilitating safe, clean, and organized workspaces in the scene shop, props room, lighting areas, and booth;
- Other duties as assigned by the department chair.

### Qualifications

- B.A. or B.S. in Theatre or related field is required.
- Experience and proficiency with scenic construction is required.
- Experience and proficiency with lighting, sound, and props is strongly desired.
- Proficiency with QLab and Vectorworks is desired.
- Ability to lift 50-pounds and to work at heights.
