ENDORSEMENTS: All elementary education majors are required to have two areas of Endorsements. <u>Reading (174)</u> will be your first Endorsement requiring 18 hours. These hours are already in your plan. For your <u>Additional Subject Area Endorsement</u>, MDE requires 18 hours to be taken in the subject content area in order to qualify for the Subject Area Endorsement. At Belhaven University the first Endorsement for all Elementary Teacher Candidates is <u>Reading</u>. The Additional Endorsement is your choice determined from the options listed below.

Endorsements in these major content subject areas will make you eligible to teach grades 7-12. If you have 18 hours in a subject area, you may request that MDE review your transcript for an endorsement to be added to your license. Look at the MDE website to determine if your 18 hours match the approved areas of endorsement. The Belhaven School of Education does require you to have the Reading Endorsement and at least one Additional Endorsement (18 hours) before you can complete the program and be recommended for licensure.
