- Mini-Fridge (5 cubic feet or less)
 - **Not allowed in UV**
- Microwave (900 watt or less)
 - **Not allowed in UV**

CLEANING

- Laundry Hamper
- Vacuum
- Air Freshener
- Cleaning Supplies
- Sponges
- Dish Soap
- Laundry Soap
- Dryer Sheets
- Toilet paper
 - *Lakeview, Helen White, and UV*

STUDYING

- Notebooks
- Textbooks
- Pens/Pencils
- Highlighters
- Folders
- Planner/Agenda
- Scissors

JUST IN CASE

- Batteries
- First Aid Kit
- Flashlight
- Tool Kit
- Non-Halogen Light Bulbs
 - *for personal lamps*
- Umbrella
- Pushpins

You may not need every item on this list.
These items are simply things you should think about bringing.

WHAT NOT TO BRING



ITEMS NOT ALLOWED

- Candles
- Electric Blankets or Heating Pads
- Firearms
- Air Fryers
- Grills
- Halogen lamps
- Hotplates
- Hoverboards
- Incense
- Lava Lamps
- Lofting Kits
- Multiple Outlet Converters without Surge Protectors
- Peel & Stick LED Light Strips
- Personal Routers
- Space Heaters
- TV Wall Mount
- Toilet Tablets
- Wax Warmer
- Weapons - Including Toy Weapons
- Window Air Conditioning Unit

Please refer to Belhaven's Student Handbook **The Kilt** for other items not allowed on campus.

DECORATION

While the personalization of rooms is encouraged, the following guidelines **MUST** be followed as residents are accountable for any damage to University furnishings or equipment.

CAN USE:

- Command Strips
 - *Not recommended for Helen White & University Village.*
- Painters Tape

CAN NOT USE:

- Nails or Screws
- Tacks
 - *Approved for use in Helen White*
- Cinderblocks or any other material that is not specifically designed to lift beds.
- Clear packing tape, Duct Tape, or masking tape.
- Mounting squares or double-sided adhesive squares
- Clear adhesive hooks

Decorations should be done in good taste and may not contain nudity, inappropriate language, or promote drugs or alcohol. The display of public signs (road signs and public service signs) is also prohibited.

TIPS:

- Contact your roommate to avoid bringing duplicate items.
- Refrigerators and microwaves are limited to one per residential student.
- Mini-Fridges and Microwaves are not permitted in University Village bedrooms as the university provides one of each in the kitchen. Exceptions may be made by gaining approval from the Director of Residence Life.
